

RESOLUTION 2000-8

WHEREAS, The Board of LaPorte County Commissioners is the lead applicant for a Community Focus Fund (CFF) grant from the Indiana Department of Commerce for renovation of the Swanson Activity Center for Older Adults, 910 State Street, LaPorte, Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, the proposed project is a contributing resource in the Downtown LaPorte Historical District, which was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on September 15, 1983, and;

WHEREAS, federal and state requirements exist specifying that the proposed project's potential effects on historic resources shall be determined by the lead applicant for funds, and;

WHEREAS, such state and federal requirements also allow the lead applicant to designate an authorized representative to assume primary responsibility for coordination of the required determination of effect;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that;



Bonar Group, 158 South Napoleon Street, Valparaiso, Indiana 46383, as the consultant for Swanson Center who is the intended sub-recipient of the CFF grant funds, is hereby authorized to serve as the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners' duly authorized representative in coordinating the required determination of effect on historic resources, and;
2. That, in addition to the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners', the following additional consulting parties shall be notified and consulted with in making such determination of effect, in accordance with all guiding state and federal requirements for such process.


