RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners intends to apply for a Community Focus Fund (CFF) Grant from the Indiana Department of Commerce (IDOC) for the purpose of rehabilitating and renovating the interior and exterior of the Activity Center for Older Adults at 910 State Street, LaPorte, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C., 470 et seq.) and Section 106 regulations (C.F.R. Part 800), the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners, as the "applicant" for funding, bears the responsibility of completing the Section 106 Historical Review Process, as so delegated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Development, and

WHEREAS, the Activity Center for Older Adults at 910 State Street is located within, and is a contributing resource to, the Downtown LaPorte Historic District, which was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on September 15, 1983, and

WHEREAS, the City of LaPorte, the LaPorte County Historical Society, and the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) have been named as "consulting parties" to assist the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners in making the required determination of effect which the proposed project may have on historic resources, and

WHEREAS, detailed information describing the proposed undertaking and the area of potential effects has been provided to the above-named consulting parties with a request to provide comments with regard to possible effects which the proposed project may have on historic resources, and



WHEREAS, comments from the above-named consulting parties have been received,


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of LaPorte County Commissioners that,

1. The proposed undertaking will not adversely affect the qualities that make the Activity Center for Older Adults a contributing resource to the Downtown LaPorte Historic District.
2. The proposed undertaking will not adversely affect the qualities that make the Downtown LaPorte Historic District eligible for inclusion to the National Register of Historic Places.
3. The above-named consulting parties shall be notified of these findings and provided with copies of documentation pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 800 and the Section 106 Historic Review Process.
4. Documentation pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 800 and the Section 106 Historic Review Process shall be made available for public inspection upon request.
