

ORDINANCE 2001 - 08

**ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH STOP SIGN ON
COUNTY ROAD 1050 WEST AND ITS
INTERSECTION AT 1350 SOUTH**

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Highway Superintendent has made a study and recommendation for the need of a stop sign on County Road 1050 West at the intersection of 1350 South for southbound traffic, and;


WHEREAS, there currently exists stop signs on County Road 1350 South at its intersection with 1050 West, however, such additional sign is needed due to reoccurring and increased damage to a county guardrail located on County Road 1350 South.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners that Section 1, LaPorte County Code Section 7-14 (b) (57) is added as follows:

SECTION I. A stop sign at the intersection of County Road 1050 West at its intersection of County Road 1350 South requiring southbound traffic to stop.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance is hereby rescinded.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication and passage as prescribed by law.
