A RESOLUTION OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ACKNOWLEDGING THE SERVICES OF THE
AMERICAN STEEL WORKERS AND SUPPORT OF
U.S. HOUSE BILL 808

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners is very concerned about the future of the residents of LaPorte County, and

WHEREAS, a number of our residents are American Steelworkers, whose jobs have been put in jeopardy due to the importation and illegal dumping of steel in our county, and

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives in H B 808 proposed to safeguard the United States' Steel Industry from the foreign dumping of steel into this country and the setting of import quotas

- 1 The LaPorte County Board of Commissioners support the United States House of Representatives in H B 808, which provides in part for import relief, industry wide legacy cost sharing, steel loan guarantee agreements and additional incentives for consolidation


WHEREFORE, be it known that the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners supports the American Steelworker, and that we are in support of House Bill 808


