Enacted on the 17th day of Sept., 2002.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET THIRTY (30) FEET WIDE SHOWN AS FIFTH STREET

WHEREAS, BARBARA YOUNGGREEN have filed a petition with the LaPorte County Commissioners under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-7-3-12 and 36-7-3-13 for the vacation of a portion of Fifth Street.

WHEREAS, notice of a hearing before the LaPorte County Commissioner has been published in the LaPorte Herald Argus in its issue of August 10, 2002, publication being at least ten (10) days before the date of this hearing; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the best interests of the LaPorte County, Indiana, to vacate said portion of Fifth Street (a) because petitioner owns all contiguous property, (b) that the vacation of said portion of Fifth Street will not materially damage the adjoining property, and will relieve the County of LaPorte of future responsibility for maintaining the same, and (c) will add the property vacated to the tax rolls of the County of LaPorte, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LAPORTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of the County of LaPorte, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1.

That the portion of Fifth Street, adjacent to Lot One, Block Five, in Frederickson, Hamilton Way and Deets Addition to Union Mills, Indiana, filed in Plat Book 2, page 63 is hereby vacated, and in accordance with the law of the State of Indiana, the fee simple title to the vacated portion of Fifth Street reverts to the adjoining property owners, i.e. BARBARA YOUNGGREEN, AND JOHN BUBALO.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and passage by the LaPorte County Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, as required by law.




