**ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH LAPORTE
COUNTY HOME ADVISORY BOARD**

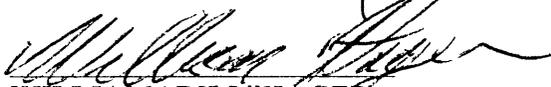
WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Commissioners have determined a need for the establishment of an Advisory Board regarding the LaPorte County Home, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of such Advisory Board is to assist the Board of Commissioners regarding the operation, use and maintenance of the LaPorte County Home.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that the LaPorte County Advisory Board is created as follows

1. That Chapter II, Article V, LaPorte County Code is amended to add Section 2-122 1, LaPorte County Home Advisory Board.
2. The body of such amendment is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit "A".
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

EXHIBIT "A"

Section 2-122 1, LaPorte County Home Advisory Board

- (a) The LaPorte County Home Advisory Board is established to assist the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners in reviewing operations, management and maintenance needs regarding the continuation and preservation of the LaPorte County Home
- (b) Such advisory board will consist of seven ~~(7)~~⁸ members all with one (1) year terms and specified as follows:
- 1 A LaPorte County Commissioner appointed by the LaPorte County Commissioners
 - 2 A LaPorte County Council person appointed by the Council.
 - 3 A medical professional, doctor or nurse, appointed by the LaPorte County Commissioners.
 4. ~~Two~~^{Two} citizen members, one ~~(1)~~² to be appointed by the LaPorte County Commissioners and one ~~(1)~~² to be appointed by the Council.
 5. The director of the LaPorte County Home by virtue of such office.
 6. Director of building maintenance by virtue of such office
- (c) The Board will meet at least quarterly to review operations and facilities and make recommendations as appropriate to the Board of Commissioners
