

ORDINANCE 2004 - 017

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH MS-4 COOPERATIVE FUNDING ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, IDEM has required local governmental entities to be involved in the storm water management plans known as MS-4; and

WHEREAS, LaPorte County has entered an MS-4 cooperative agreement with Michigan City, LaPorte County, Trail Creek and Long Beach, and

WHEREAS, all entities have agreed that LaPorte County will serve as the conduit for disbursement of funds and its overall employer regarding such program for which such entities will provide specified amounts of funds concerning such expenses; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Auditor of LaPorte County to set up non-reverting accounts regarding such funding

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:


1. The LaPorte County Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to set up all necessary fund accounts regarding the MS-4 cooperative agreement to allow for deposit of funds received from partner entities and disbursement of funds for expenditures regarding such cooperative agreement to include the hiring of additional employees.

2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication and passage as prescribed by law.
