WHEREAS, LaPorte County Highway Department and the Indiana Department of Transportation has requested the vacation of a portion of Division Street between its intersection with Poplar Street and US 20 in Rolling Prairie, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, such vacation is necessary based on the reconstruction of US 20 at that location; and


WHEREAS, this matter has been set for public hearing on the 6th day of April, 2004 at 6:00 p.m ; and


WHEREAS, all adjoining landowners have been sent notice regarding this public hearing.


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:


1. The a portion of Division Street located in Rolling Prairie, Indiana between Poplar Street and US 20 is hereby vacated.






PUBLIC NOTICE


