

ORDINANCE 2004 - 11

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH 20MPH SPEED LIMITS IN SUBDIVISIONS

WHEREAS, due to the continued growth and development of residential subdivisions within LaPorte County, there is a continuous need to establish speed limits on new streets developed in such subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of adopting ordinances for each individual street, a general ordinance is hereby adopted establishing such speed limits


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:

SECTION I. Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 7-3 is hereby amended to include all residential subdivision streets in LaPorte County not otherwise posted will have a speed limit of 20 MPH


SECTION II. Posting will occur only after the development of such street.


SECTION III. That this ordinance shall take effect after its publication and passage as prescribed by law.
