Additional Submittal Requirements:

- 1) Site Plan-to locate proposed development in relation to roads, streams waterbodies.
- 2) A legal description of property.
- 3) Photographs of existing site conditions.
- 4) Soils information, if available with existing grades (proposed if available).
- 5) Provide information if in a floodway/floodplain, elevation of 100 yr. flood.
- 6) Elevation of the lowest proposed floor.
- 7) Site impact of disturbed area-size (acres).
- 8) Provide any copies of IDEM, IDNR or USACE permits, if available, or if required.
- 9) Any copies of recorded easements that affect the site showing construction limits.

Application is adequate: A comprehensive application review has been completed and it has been determined that the application satisfies the minimum requirements and intent of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance, Article 20, Sec 20.12, Application Stage, as adopted January, 2012.

Application is deficient: significant deficiencies were identified during the application review.

Upon approval of this application, please forward a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), to the Local MS4 Coordinator for approval. This approval is required prior to obtaining a local building permit!

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SITE
DEVELOPMENT PERMIT FEE

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 2007-07 the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners established a Site Development Permit Fee in the amount of \$100 to be collected for all Site Development Permits; and,

WHEREAS, said fee is currently insufficient to cover the expenses of the LaPorte County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4); and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County MS4 and Board of Commissioners desire to amend the Site Development Permit Fee in a manner that is equitable to site owners of various sizes of projects,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, that:

The Site Development Permit Fee is amended to read as One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per acre of disturbance.


